

## **Developing & implementing a Pedestrian Slip Resistance Strategy for Auckland Transport**

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AT is focussed on user safety, with the increasing public transport assets, it is important that the intents of AT are communicated in an effective manner. To ensure clarity, we developed the AT Pedestrian Slip Resistance Strategy.

The pedestrian strategy sets the minimum wet slip resistance requirement for all surfaces accessible by pedestrians in the Auckland region. This includes walkways, footpaths, town centres (under AT control) and public transport facilities. The strategy aligns with the current minimum standard set in the NZ Building Code for publicly accessible surfaces.

The presentation will cover the strategies, and provide the audience with options that may be useful for their networks, and provide exposure in a relatable medium to slip resistance as an asset management technique.
